Directive Number: MACB - 1

SUBJECT: MacBAIN PROPERTIES LTD.

MacBain Properties will contribute up to a maximum of \$300.00 (or up to \$150.00 for employees identified as “Seasonal”) towards the cost of prescription safety glasses every 24 months, unless there is a change in prescription. Any costs exceeding these amounts will be the responsibility of the employee and are to be paid according to an invoice that will accompany the finished glasses when returned from the lab. You are to collect and remit to the AAO.

Effective: January 28, 2014

Program Type: Voluntary – **Employer/ Employee** Contribution. **Employee** is responsible for the vision examination fee if provincial health care is not available. **Employee** can claim for vision exam through their insurance benefit program.

Optical Lab: Approved laboratory as listed in Manual Insert OVC-GI-2.

Safety Frames: Any CSA approved safety frame from the On-Guard line of frames will be allowed. (MacBain will provide employees with Rx inserts when necessary for respirators)

Exclusions: **UVEX and Wiley-X frames will not be allowed**

Side shields **Fixed side shields are mandatory.**

Lens Material:

Glass **NOT ALLOWED.**

Plastic Allowed.

Polycarbonate Allowed.

Hi-Index Allowed provided sphere and cylinder when added together are greater than 6 dioptres. ****Note lenses must not be less than 3mm center thickness. ****

Lens Treatments:

S/R Coating **ALWAYS** applied to plastic and polycarbonate lenses.

U/V Coating **Allowed**

A/R Coating **Allowed (No Ice or Alize)**

Tints **NOT ALLOWED**

(Over...)

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Transitions **Allowed**

Progressive Bifocals Allowed if currently in dress eyewear

Seamless Multifocal Allowed if currently in dress eyewear
