SUBJECT: MANLUK INDUSTRIES INC.

The Employer will contribute up to a maximum of \$250.00 towards the purchase of prescription safety eyewear for their employees. Any amounts exceeding \$250.00 are to be collected from the employee at the time of dispensing according to an invoice that will accompany the finished pair of glasses when returned from the lab. These amounts are to be collected and remitted to the AAO.

Effective: November 1, 2008

Program Type: Employer / Employee Contribution. **Employee** responsible for vision examination fee if provincial health care is not available.

Optical Lab: We have two approved labs – one in Edmonton and one in Calgary

Safety Frames:

Exclusions None. Any CSA approved safety frame from approved list

Sideshields **FIXED SIDESHIELDS ARE MANDATORY**

Lens Material:

Glass **NOT ALLOWED**

Plastic Allowed.

Polycarbonate Allowed.

Hi-Index Allowed provided sphere and cylinder when added together are greater than 6 dioptres, or clinically recommended by doctor. “”Note lenses must not be less than 3 mm centre thickness**

Lens Treatments:

S/R Coating **ALWAYS applied** to all lenses

U/V Coating **Allowed** if required for occupational reasons or with prior written authorization

A/R Coating **Allowed** with prior written authorization

Tints Up to 30% density – **if required for clinical or occupational reasons.**

(OVER)

Photochromatics **NOT ALLOWED**

Progressive Addition **Allowed** if currently in dress eyewear or clinically required

Seamless Bifocals **Allowed** if currently in dress eyewear or clinically required
