Exclusions	Titanium frames not allowed.
Sideshields	FIXED SIDESHIELDS ARE REQUIRED.
Lens Material:	
Glass	NOT ALLOWED.
Plastic	Allowed.
Polycarbonate	NOT ALLOWED.
Hi-Index	Allowed provided sphere and cylinder when added together are greater than 6 diopters. **Note lenses must not be less than 3 mm centre thickness.**
Lens Treatments:	
S/R Coating	ALWAYS applied to plastic lenses.
U/V Coating	Allowed with PRIOR WRITTEN approval on authorization form.
A/R Coating	Allowed in conjunction with Hi-Index lenses only.
Tints	Allowed. Up to 30% density Neutral Grey.
Photochromatics	NOT ALLOWED.
Progressive Addition	Allowed if currently in dress eyewear.
Seamless Bifocals	Allowed if currently in dress eyewear.
Special Materials:	If required please contact the AAO office (488-7027 – Edmonton or 1-800-272-8843) prior to ordering.
Practitioner Note:	Planos are not allowed. Millar Western supplies Plano eyewear to employees who do not require prescription eyewear.
