Schedule D Criteria Sheet outlines the company's policy and restrictions with regards to frames, lenses and coatings for safety prescription eyewear orders through Eyesafe. Exceptions to the policy must be approved by the company and written on the job order to be fulfilled.

Established Date / Revisions September 2008, **Revised June 2019**

Eye Exams: Employee responsible for vision exam fee if provincial health care is not available.

Contribution Limit: The Company will subsidize 100% of the cost of the employee's prescription safety glasses.

Optical Lab: Any lab approved by the Alberta Association of Optometrists.

Safety Frames: Any CSA (Z94.3) compliant safety frame on the program - Frame **MUST HAVE A SEAL OR DUST DAM.**

Frame Restrictions Sealed eyewear or dust dam required only.

Side Shield Fixed side shields are mandatory.

Lens Material:

Approved Materials Plastic Polycarbonate Trivex

If material is not checked above, the material is restricted from use.

Lens Treatments:

Scratch Resistant Coating Allowed and applied to all lenses.

Ultra Violet Coating Allowed.

Anti-Reflective Coating Not allowed.
(Anti-reflective is not available on CR39 plastic lens as per CSA requirements)

Tints Allowed if approved from management and included **to a 30% density.**

Photochromatics Allowed and included if approved from management.
(Photochromatics is not available on Trivex lenses as per CSA requirements)

Safety Cases Cases are provided for all safety eyewear orders.
