<b>Exam:</b>	See below for vision exam fee if provincial health care is not available.
<b>Contribution Limit:</b>	Company will contribute \$230.00 including the cost of eye exams once every two years for employee's safety eyewear.  Any costs exceeding these amounts are the responsibility of the employee and are to be collected by the Doctor's office at the time of dispensing. An invoice will accompany the final eyewear sent to the optometric clinic.
<b>Optical Lab:</b>	Any contracted lab approved by the Alberta Association of Optometrists.
<b>Safety Frames:</b>	Any CSA (Z94.3) compliant safety frame on the program.
<i>Side Shield</i>	Fixed side shields are required. <b>(CSA frames will only be allowed fixed side shields)</b>
<b>Lens Material:</b>	
Glass	<b>NOT ALLOWED.</b> (Glass lenses do not meet CSA standards)

<b>Lens Treatments:</b>	
Scratch Resistant Coating	ALWAYS applied to lenses.
Ultra Violet Coating	Allowed. At employee's expense.
Anti-Reflective Coating	Anti Reflective Coating – Allowed. <b>(Anti-reflective is not available on CR39 plastic lens as per CSA requirements)</b>
Tints	Allowed - Up to 30% density. – at employee's expense.
Photochromatics	Allowed. At employees expense. <b>(Photochromatics is not available on Trivex lenses as per CSA requirements)</b>
