



Schedule D - EYESAFE Criteria Sheet

Exam:	Employer responsible for vision examination fee.
Optical Lab:	Any contracted lab approved by the Alberta Association of Optometrists.
Safety Frames:	Any CSA (Z94.3) or ANSI (Z87.1) compliant safety frame on the program.
<i>Frame Restrictions</i>	Without restrictions, all compliant frames will be available in program. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Close Fit Frame Only Required (no flat frames in program)
<i>Side Shield</i>	Fixed side shields are required.
Lens Material:	
Glass	NOT ALLOWED. (Glass lenses do not meet CSA standards)
Approved Materials	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Plastic <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Polycarbonate <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Trivex If material is not checked above, the material is <u>restricted</u> from use.
Computer Lenses	Digitime lenses are not allowed on program.
Lens Treatments:	
Scratch Resistant Coating	ALWAYS applied to lenses.
Ultra Violet Coating	Allowed.
Anti-Reflective Coating	Anti Reflective Coating – Allowed if required for high prescriptions only. (Anti-reflective is not available on CR39 plastic lens as per CSA requirements)
Tints	Allowed - Up to 30% density – neutral grey only.
Photochromatics	Allowed. Clip's on is also allowed if requested by employee (for certain frame models). (Photochromatics is not available on Trivex lenses as per CSA requirements)
