



Schedule D - EYESAFE Criteria Sheet

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**Exam:** Employee responsible for vision exam fee if provincial health care is not available.

**Contribution Limit:** Employer responsibility.

**Optical Lab:** Any contracted lab approved by the Alberta Association of Optometrists.

**Safety Frames:**  Any CSA (Z94.3) compliant safety frame on the program.  
(Check if applicable)  Any CSA (Z94.3) or ANSI (Z87.1) compliant safety frame on the program.

*Frame Restrictions* Without restrictions, all compliant frames will be available in program.

- Close Fit Frame Only Required (no flat frames in program)
- Sealed Eyewear Only Required
- Dust Dam Required
- Non Conductive Frame Only Required
- Flat Frames

*Side Shield* Fixed side shields are required.  
**(CSA frames will only be allowed fixed side shields)**

**Lens Material:**

Glass **NOT ALLOWED.** (Glass lenses do not meet CSA standards)

Approved Materials  Plastic  Polycarbonate  Trivex

If material is not checked above, the material is restricted from use.

Computer Lenses Digitime lenses are not allowed on program.

**Lens Treatments:**

Scratch Resistant Coating ALWAYS applied to lenses.

Ultra Violet Coating Allowed at employee's expense

Anti-Reflective Coating Allowed at employee's expense  
**(Anti-reflective is not available on CR39 plastic lens as per CSA requirements)**

Tints Allowed at employee's expense - Up to 30% density.

Photochromatics Allowed at employee's expense  
**(Photochromatics is not available on Trivex lenses as per CSA requirements)**
